


Fig 1. Link Street 88E6060 SOHO Switch Internal Block Diagram

The 88E6060 device contains PHYs, LED drivers, voltage regulator logic, switch logic, and memory. The only active components required to implement a complete 88E6060 10/100 Ethernet switch are a 25 MHz crystal clock source and a low cost PNP transistors used by the 88E6060 device's voltage regulator to generate 1.5V and 2.5V from 3.3V.




Fig 2. Firewall Router Application
