



RATING AND CHARACTERISTIC CURVES UF600 THRU UF608




Fig. 1-REVERSE RECOVERY TIME CHARACTERISTIC AND TEST CIRCUIT DIAGRAM






Fig. 2-FORWARD CHARACTERISTICS

Fig. 4-TYPICAL REVERSE LEAKAGE CHARACTERISTICS








Fig. 5-PEAK FORWARD SURGE CURRENT
